

AUDIOLOGY




Desert Voices is excited to announce that we have launched a fully operating audiological suite onsite! The success of our comprehensive LSL program relies heavily on the ability of the child's amplification to work properly and have optimal programming. Previously, we partnered with an audiologist from Phoenix Children's Hospital, who assessed the student's hearing devices weekly, ensuring proper fit and assessing overall functionality. This service was a great benefit to families and allowed students to receive instantaneous care instead of waiting weeks for an audiology appointment. We recently expanded this successful program to having full-time comprehensive audiology services on-site, including audiological evaluations, regular hearing testing, device fitting and programming, earmold fitting, and troubleshooting. Students having immediate access to these services maximizes the benefits of their LSL education. Through our newly established partnership with Medical Service Providers, we can now offer comprehensive audiological services to qualifying families based on Federal Poverty Level criteria, ensuring that economic circumstances don't prevent children from accessing the hearing support they need to succeed.




FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

EXPENSES \$1,236,659.44




SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

FUTURE OUTLOOK

PROGRAMS

In order to ensure we are maintaining best practices in the field of Listening and Spoken Language, we are continuously making adjustments to all four of our educational programs. Every child's journey is unique, and we tailor our approach to ensure their success. This upcoming year we added a self-contained kindergarten classroom for five students. We are excited to see the growth these students will make before they mainstream in the spring of 2026

AUDIOLOGY

With the introduction of audiology services, Desert Voices is deepening our community impact and extending support to more families than ever before. Access to sound is fundamental to a child's spoken language development, yet many families face barriers in maintaining their child's hearing devices or securing proper audiological care. We are actively pursuing funding opportunities to support families who need these critical services, including providing hearing aids when financial resources are limited.

LEGISLATION

We are continuing our efforts with legislation to ensure all families have access to equitable information on language and therapy approaches for their deaf or hard of hearing child. We want every family to know there is help for their child's Listening and Spoken Language journey. Our goal is to empower families with all of the information necessary to make an informed decision about the best communication options for their child and family.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH
